




#### Welcome!

I am so excited to share this resource with you. This package is all about diving into Core Competency learning in an interactive way.

Students will expand their understanding of the three Core
Competencies and 7 sub-competencies within the BC Curriculum; making personal
connections, setting and reviewing individual goals, and engaging in self-assessments.

The activities are designed for use throughout the year, and support building a bank of artifacts for a personalized learning portfolio.



Each of the seven sub-competencies contain 3-4 aspects, known as facets. Exploring sub-competencies and facets helps to broaden students' understanding of the Core Competencies, and assists with personal goal setting and self-assessment.

















### **About the Package**

Inside you will find interactive pages and activities for supporting students with their understanding, goal-setting, and self-assessment of the BC Core Competencies. Whether you are a BC educator, a homelearning parent, or have an interest in competency based/personalized learning, this package offers many unique and fun ideas!









#### A Closer Look...

The first section focuses on deepening students' understanding of the **Core Competencies** and smaller **sub-competencies** held within. Hands-on activities extend awareness and help form personal connections to the competencies, which sparks individualized learning goals.



The next section focuses on **goal setting**, **self-reflection** and **self-assessment** of competency goals. Students choose personal competency goals, and move into reflecting on work, self-assessing growth, celebrating achievements, identifying future goals, sharing work samples, and tracking progress.




















The last section includes **labels and display material** to draw attention to the competencies, as well as printable blank templates for activity extensions, and bonus lined paper for use with interactive flaps.



For the interactive pages students will need: scissors, glue, a notebook/folder/paper, something to color with, and a pencil, or pen, for writing. The fold and flip tabs are set up to be used quickly and easily, requiring a pair of scissors and a pencil for drawing/writing.



Larger versions of images and pie charts are also included to place under the tabs, that illustrate themes and facets within the





#### Competencies Full Page Flip Tabs - Variations included to suit all grade levels




A fun way to introduce or review the competencies, is to make these interactive flaps. Not only is it a great hands on activity, it can be referred to many times over the course of the year

This is more detailed than the previous pages, with all sub-competencies showing. Pages can be mixed and matched allowing for differentiation, For what you see when you open the flaps.

Two pages are needed for this activity. The top flap and the inside flap. Students cut out the pieces from the first page and glue onto the second sheet. The Finished interactive sheet can be pasted into a large notebook of folder, to be kept handy for future use.









#### Word Searches - Multiple Grade Ranges






There are different els of word puzzles, allowing for differentiation and multiple grade use.

#### Bookmarks - Multiple Grade Ranges




- Ideas for Use
- > Print on card stock or have students paste their bookmarks on a piece of construction paper to make them sturdy. Students can color and keep their bookmarks to use through the term.
- ightharpoons The bookmarks can be used as a springboard, into a discussion on competencies What does this competency mean to you' Can you think of examples of activities for them? Can you think of examples in your day to day life that align with them? What competencies do you feel are your strengths What areas would you like to grow, and why?
- Different bookmarks can be handed out throughout the year depending on competency areas of focus in class
- As an option, students can select a bookmark, based on the area of their goals, to color and keep. Bookmarks can be laminated for long term use.

#### OMPETENCY SORTING ACTIVITY 🌣 IDEAS FOR USE 🦊



Sorting 'I Can' competency statements helps build students' understanding of the competencies, and provides an opportunity for reflection on how much they engage in these skills. It also assists students in identifying skills and areas that they may wish to grow further.


#### Ideas for Use

- > Have students make the scrting envelopes. Hand out 'I Can' competency statements that are included in this package. The 'I Can' statements have been adapted from SD 62 Learning Commons Posters Students can cut out, read and reflect on how much each statement describes them at the present time (a little, pretty much, a lot). Have students place each 'I Can' statement into the envelope that fits best.
- For younger students, this can be done as a class activity. Students can place the labelled envelopes on their desk. Teachers can read 'I Can' statements aloud. As the teacher reads a statement, students can tap an envelope on their desk to show how much it describes them at the present time (a little, pretty much, a lot)
- Throughout the year, this activity can be repeated, and students can see how their skills are evolving. It also lends itself to reviewing at student-led conferences.



There are templates with blank spaces for students to draw/write, sheets with sentence starters, and interactive fold and flip tabs, to assist students in self-assessment.









The tracking sheets provide an opportunity for students to track their competency learning journey, by recording gods, activities, progress, and future plans.


They also provide a visual overview of Core Competencies engaged in, and areas that have yet to be worked on.

- The tracking sheets can be filled out as a whole class activity, or students can be encouraged to fill them out on their own. For early primary grades the teacher may wish to scribe for students. The tracking sheets can be used at regular intervals throughout the year.
- > A variety of sheets have been included, to offer a range for different grades. You can choose the one(s) you feel would be best for your students. Some pages have more room to draw/write, which is particularly handy for younger students. Although, you may find these roomy sheets handy for older grades tool
- Tracking sheets can be kept in a duo-tang folder or glued into a large notebook.


#### Ideas for Use

- As students create and engage in competency goals, you can use these sheets to keep a record of student progress. le., personal learning goals, competency areas covered, work samples shared, future plans identified.
- Have printed record sheets handy, taking notes as convenient, to assist with supporting individual competency learning. Teachers can keep an eye out for students engaging in their goals and offer support by noticing, encouraging, and celebrating learning as it unfolds.
- > The information gathered on fracking sheets can assist in student reporting sharing competencies of focus and individual goals
- Two of the sheets include stages of progress for tracking extra information on competency godis (le, noting when a student's goal is set, started in progress, and met). This can be gathered from student self-assessments through the year.

There are blank and lined templates for students to suit a range of grades. Cut and paste labels have been included to assist with classroom organization. They can be used on covers or folders to keep work samples organized.




